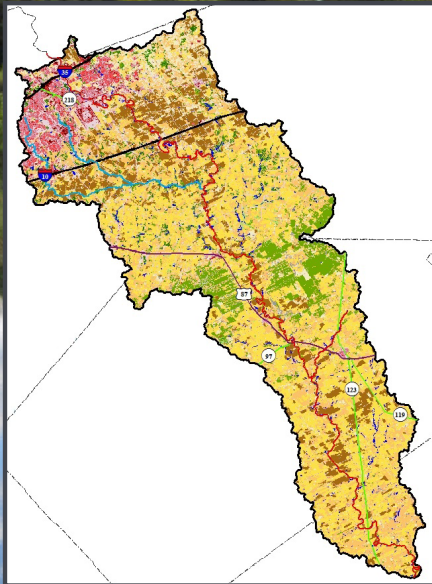


# TEXAS Watershed Steward
