The Geronimo and Alligator Creek Partnership will conduct a mini-tour of the watershed on Tuesday November 1st, at 1:30pm. The draft Watershed Protection Plan was recently completed and is posted on the project website (http://www.geronimocreek.org/). The purpose of the tour is to better explain and illustrate what impacts the WPP will potentially have on the local area.
